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Management Systems

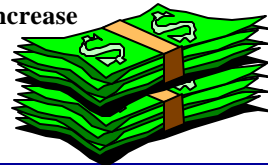
- **Business systems or management systems are established and implemented to define and control how businesses operate.**

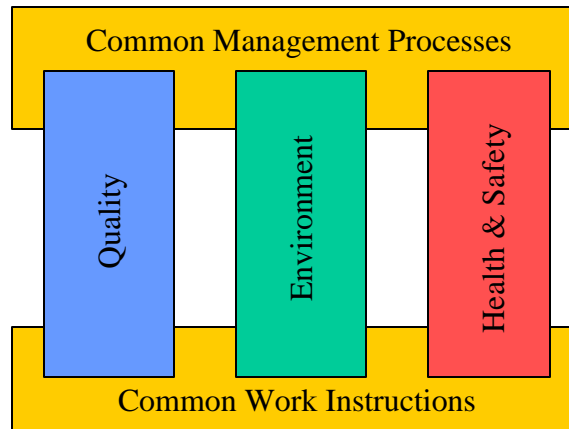
- The answer to avoid “Entropy”

- Independent Internal Audits

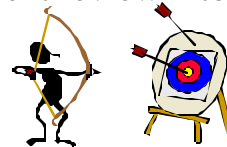


Integrated Management Systems



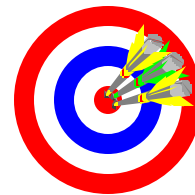
Optimize Integrated Management Systems through Business Planning:
