Environmental Site Assessor Certification

Objectives

- ➤ to develop a credible national certification program for environmental site assessors
- ➤ to develop a program that provides end users access to qualified environmental site assessors anywhere in Canada

- Certification process has the support of the banks
- ➤ the goal is to have a CCESA as a requirement for all ESAs performed for the banks and other lending institutions
- ➤ CIBC and Royal Bank have been approached and support the certification program
- CEAA will petition CBA to get Canada-wide acceptance of the CCESA designation

Environmental Site Assessor Certification

- ➤ An *adhoc* committee was struck several years ago at the board level
 - members included various consulting groups and Doug Bisset
- ➤ At the 2000 strategy session in Calgary it was decided to proceed with the certification program
- ➤ Grandparenting criteria were developed and agreed upon in 2001

Grandparenting Criteria

- > 10 years or more of ESA experience
- > must conduct or madage a minimum of 20 ESAs/year
- > must have conducted or managed at least 100 ESA 's
- > must have either a CET or university degree
- > must be a CEAA member in good standing
- > must have professional errors and omissions insurance
- > consideration will be given to certification by AQVE, APEA, or AESAC but does not guarantee grandparenting

Standards / Guidance Documents

- ➤ A BOSK for CEAS's has been developed
- CSA Z768-01 Phase I Environmental Site Assessments
- ➤ ASTM E1527-00 Standard Practice for ESA's: Phase I ESA Process

- ➤ Applicants had to provide details of ESA experience with references
- ➤ Applicants had to provide proof of professional errors and omissions insurance
- For Grandparented individuals have to actively participate in the development of the certification program
