Certification - Issues

- ◆ Awaiting SCC re-accreditation (process started last October)
- ◆ SCC has eliminated required accredited certification for registrars
- ◆ Do we need SCC accreditation for auditor certification ?
- ◆ New exam – ready to go for all designations
- ◆ Determine revised designations – one for all or ???
- ◆ Other – GHG Verifiers, Social Responsibility auditing
- ◆ H&S Auditor designations - ready
